PROCESS

1. An application of a person for membership of the Branch must—
 - (a) be made in writing in the form set out here; and
 - (b) be lodged with the Secretary of the Association.
2. As soon as practicable after the receipt of an application, the Secretary must refer the application to the committee.
3. The committee must determine whether to approve or reject the application.
4. If the committee approves an application for membership, the Secretary must, as soon as practicable—
 - (a) notify the applicant in writing of the approval for membership; and
 - (b) request payment within 28 days after receipt of the notification of the sum payable under these Rules as the entrance fee and the first year's annual subscription.
5. The Secretary must, within 28 days after receipt of the amounts referred to above, enter the applicant's name in the register of members.
6. An applicant for membership becomes a member and is entitled to exercise the rights of membership when his or her name is entered in the register of members.
7. If the committee rejects an application, the committee must, as soon as practicable, notify the applicant in writing that the application has been rejected.
